Please do it quickly, so that your artists can receive their applications in time to submit their entries by the May 29 deadline.

To assist you in this outreach program, we provide you with a poster which you are welcome to hang on a bulletin board where your faculty and students can see it.

We are looking forward to seeing the scope of your artists' works, and hope that you contact us with any questions you may have.
